

Itineraries for the Harvey Harvest Festival

Option 1: Two-Day Weekend Escape

Take your time on Saturday with a relaxed introduction to the region, enjoy an overnight stay along the coast, then dive into a full day of festival activities on Sunday.

Option 2: One-Day Festival Experience

Two versions of a focused day trip to the region, packed with the highlights of the Harvey Harvest Festival.

Day 1 - Saturday March 7th:

Morning

- Get ‘hands-on’ and unleash your creativity at the Local Emporio **Harvest Window Adorn Creative Workshop**—designed to bring the colours, textures, and spirit of Harvey’s orange harvest right into your home.
- Drop in to see the iconic **Big Orange** at **Harvey River Estate**, featuring a 10-metre tower topped with an additional 4-metre climb to reach the viewing platform inside the orange itself. Taste and purchase from the range of local wines and fresh orange juice! *

Lunch

- Set amongst the beauty of our agricultural heartland, the **Harvey Harvest Long Table Lunch** at Uduc Hall brings together growers, producers, chefs, and friends for a shared feast showcasing the very best of the season. *

Evening

- Combine creative with all things harvest at **Harvey Farm Barn’s Pick Your Own Flowers Workshop**.
- Visit **Brugan Brewery** for the Harvey Harvest Sundowner. Soak in the atmosphere with live music, delicious local flavours, and great company. Or join **Geovino** for a curated celebration of local Italian-style wines and Harvey Region produce.



Day 2 – Sunday March 8th – Festival Day:

Version 1 – A Day of Art, Culture & Taste

- 10am Start your day at **Stirling Cottage Kitchen*** with a relaxed morning tea overlooking the Harvey River. Then wander through the beautiful gardens on the **May Gibbs Trail**, discovering the stories behind *Snugglypot and Cuddleprie*, or visit **Boola Bidi Dreaming Centre**, a cultural and creative hub, to explore local art and products.
- 11.30am Arrive in Harvey town and explore the arts and culture hub: the **Shire of Harvey Art Prize Exhibition** in a heritage church, local **craft displays** and “have a go” craft activities, coffee under the trees, plus a **historical exhibition** in the beautiful Town Hall.
- 12.30pm Head towards the festival, stopping at **Little Italy in the Piazza** for a bite to eat. Soak up the charming piazza atmosphere, and enjoy a lively performance by Mr Accordion Man.
- 1.30pm Wander through the **festival at Snell’s Park**, where you’ll find **local produce, artisan markets, and live entertainment**. Enjoy the vibrant Harvey Filipino Dancers and Italian singer and guitarist Carmine Napoli.
- 3pm Don’t miss the grand finale of the festival! Watch the fun and frenzy of the **WA Grape Stomping Championships**, where participants stomp their way to glory in a celebration of harvest, laughter, and local wine culture.
- 4pm **Return home** after a full day of exploring, tasting, and enjoying the festivities.



Day 2 – Sunday March 8th – Festival Day:

Version 2 – Taste of Harvey

- 10.30am Discover **Vineyard 28's** story and their passion for all things Italian with a **guided wine tasting**. Savor a selection of their wines perfectly paired with a **tasting plate** and enjoy the rich flavours and warm hospitality that make this vineyard a true taste of Italy in Harvey. *
- 12pm Next stop, **Harvey Cheese** to taste a selection of **locally made cheeses** or treat yourself to a delicious ice cream. While you're here, sample **handcrafted spirits from St Duke's**, made from locally sourced whey and refined in small batches. *
- 1pm Landing in town, wander through the main street towards **Snell's Park** where you'll find a cooking demonstration with **Perth's Celebrity Butcher, Vince Garreffa** at the **Old Coast Road Brewery Taste of Harvey** area.
- 2pm Dive further into the festival where you'll find **local produce, artisan markets, and live entertainment**. Enjoy the vibrant Harvey Filipino Dancers and Italian singer and guitarist Carmine Napoli.
- 3pm Don't miss the grand finale of the festival! Watch the fun and frenzy of the **WA Grape Stomping Championships**, where participants stomp their way to glory in a celebration of harvest, laughter, and local wine culture.
- 4pm **Return home** after a full day of exploring, tasting, and enjoying the festivities.
